A primary election will be held in the towns, villages, and cities of Marinette County on Tuesday, August 11, 2026, and an election will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026. The following officers are to be nominated and elected:

For Candidates

The first day to circulate nomination papers is April 15, 2026, and the final day for filing nomination papers is 5:00 p.m. on Monday, June 1, 2026. Candidates for constitutional, congressional, and legislative officers file with the Wisconsin Elections Commission. All county partisan office candidates file with their respective County Clerk. Congressional and legislative district

boundaries are described in Chapters 3 and 4 of the Wisconsin Statutes. A copy of the boundary descriptions can be obtained from the Wisconsin Elections Commission at 212 East Washington Avenue, 3rd Floor, PO Box 7984, Madison or the Legislative Reference Bureau at 1 East Main Street, Suite 200, Madison, Wisconsin.
