DeShea Morrow spoke to give an update on 2025. The DA office is open 24/7 to help the Police departments. The top 3 items the office is working on is: 1. The high number of traffic fatalities. 2. The drugs coming through the county. 3. Sexual assaults on children. This takes a lot of police and

district attorney time and resources. The state has frozen levies to the county. The county has a referendum on the ballot in April asking for a higher levy to be used for public services. There is more demand because our county is a rural county. One goal is for the police departments to use a computer program that will interface with the program at the DA's office.

9) Fire Truck Acquisition: Motion by Trustee: George Gocht, seconded by Trustee Michael Strandt, to purchase a 1999 Pierce Saber Pumper from the Village of Fox Crossing for \$25,000.
